

Notification of the Department of Intellectual Property
Re: The Expression of the Will to Uphold Integrity in Administration

To ensure that the Department of Intellectual Property is administered in line with the principles of good governance and by adherence to the principles of “state of the people, for the people and the public interest” and to achieve the public affairs efficiently and economically, facilitate and respond to the needs of the people, following the Royal Decree on Criteria and Procedures for Good Governance B.E. 2546 (2003), the Official Information Act B.E. 2540 (1997), and the Civil Service Act B.E. 2551 (2008), the Department of Intellectual Property executives hereby declare the intention to perform their duties and administrate the organization with honesty, transparency and in accordance with the principles of good governance, maintain themselves with honor and dignity, implement public policy, and focus on improving and enhancing the performance of the personnel to abide themselves by moral and ethical standards of the Department of Intellectual Property as follows:

1. Determine to administrate in adherence to good governance principles and strictly perform duties compliance with laws, rules and regulations;
2. Encourage all officials and staff to adhere to the four desirable virtues, including sufficiency, discipline, integrity, and volunteerism;
3. Promote and support work processes in accordance with the organizational culture of the Department of Intellectual Property, namely transparency, service mindset, and anti-corruption;
4. Raise conscience and awareness within the department and enable them to differentiate between personal and public interests in order to promote and support the effective work process of anti-corruption; and
5. Resist any corrupt behavior and strictly punish offenders on the basis of the rule of law.
